This fun "cool song" is a primer level piece and only uses the notes C D E F and G. It is in the C major pentascale position. The left hand plays a third interval (measure one) and then a sixth interval (measure two), and then repeats that in measures three and four. The student then plays both hands together for measures five and six. Only Whole notes, Half notes, and Quarter notes are used in this "cool song". Have fun!
